

**The meridian ellipses and
the Jubilees 1700-2025**

The Polaris through the *salutiferous cross*, draws the ellipses around the celestial north pole, each 25 years



1725 Clemens XIII
new hospitals in Rome
Stellar aberration discovery
Bianchini maps Venus




1700 Clemens XI
financed the Meridian Line.
He closed the Jubilee.
Earth's axis motions and
Earth's shape under study
Newton invited Msgr.Bianchini
in the Royal Society of London.

1750 Benedict XIV
restaured the Basilica
Boscovich SJ revised the
meridian line

1800 Pius VII elected in Venice, no Jubilee as in
1850 and 1875: Popes persecuted
Collegio Romano Observatory-Angelo Secchi SJ



Mathematical and real Jubilees



Measured latitude: +16° North
Cause: Stellar Aberration!
